Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Offset Program

- Saskatchewan is primarily establishing the program as a compliance option for the province's regulated industries to account for their annual emission reduction targets
- Program aligns with provincial, federal and international standards to ensure a wide and competitive market for credits
- Provides carbon offset credits to project developers who use approved protocols to voluntarily reduce or remove GHG emissions
- Program set to launch with four protocols recognizing landfill gas management, aerobic composting, farming and ranching
- The Ministry will continue engagement with stakeholders in fall 2021



Cumulative Effects Analysis

Some Current Projects, Cumulative Effects Analyses

- Quantifying provincial ecosystem carbon sinks and sources
- Modeling carbon emissions and sequestration of natural ecosystems in changing environments (e.g., peat)
- Comparison of natural systems sequestration potential to carbon capture technology
- Carbon lifecycle analyses (e.g., canola oil and biofuel, timber) and methods for carbon monetization
- Climate change and land management implications for GHG emissions and sequestration



Resilience Measurement Framework

The **Climate Resilience Measurement Framework** is a government-wide approach to measuring progress on building climate resilience in Saskatchewan.



25 key measures that demonstrate how Saskatchewan is supporting a healthy, resilient environment




Mineral Exploration & Duty to Consult

Saskatchewan Environmental Code

February 2021 changes:

- aligning code development to the ministry's annual strategic planning
- discontinuing the Code Advisory Committee

Public and stakeholder engagement remain a key tenet of results-based regulation and code chapter development.

Code chapters in development (using new approach):

- Compost

Code chapters approved to proceed:

- Work in or Near Water
- Forest Operations
- Hazardous Substance Storage



Protected Areas (PAs)

Clearly defined geographical spaces.
Recognized, dedicated and managed for longterm conservation values. Governance and ownership recognizes conservation objectives.

Other Effective Area-Based Conservation Measures (OECMs)

Clearly defined geographical spaces. Not protected areas, but governance and management approach results in long-term conservation in addition to other values.

Governance and ownership recognizes conservation objectives.



Solid Waste Management Strategy

- 2021-22 Priorities
 - Development of a comprehensive communications strategy and education campaign
 - Finalizing an assessment of barriers to regional waste management and options to reduce them
 - Finalization of two Saskatchewan Environmental Code Chapters
 - Transfer Stations
 - Composting Facilities
 - Developing a baseline report on organic and food waste in the province



Environmental Assessment Guideline Review

- Technical Proposal Guidelines
 - Clarified emissions information submission requirements
 - Proposals will be posted online (even if no-EIA determination)
- Guidelines for the Terms of Reference and Environmental Impact Statement
 - New table format to identify information expectations for TOR vs. EIS
 - Administrative submission requirements
- Stakeholder engagement concluded July 7, 2021
- Final guidelines expected this year

Active projects:

Federal Carbon Pricing Benchmark 2023-2030

- Maintaining the Carbon Pricing Signal
 - Cannot negate the carbon pricing signal
 - 1:1 generation of performance credits
 - Balanced supply and demand for credits
- Complete OBPS Coverage
 - Similar scope of coverage for combustion emissions, coverage of industrial process emissions, no partial OBPS backstop
- Application of federal backstop until 2026; interim review in 2026
- Engagement and Next Steps



Small Modular Reactor (SMR) Update

- MOU provinces jointly released a Feasibility Report (April 2021)
- SMR Discussion Paper received highly-informed and positive feedback (April 2021)
- Progressing with the MOU Strategic Plan, including a Saskatchewan Appendix (anticipated release Fall 2021)
- Preparing a Federal Funding Request for SMR Planning Phase
- Preparing a Request for Proposal (RFP) with SaskBuilds and Procurement for a detailed Business Case
