A TYPICAL DAY: "Today I coordinate the loading and delivery of freight in another province or country, and tomorrow I hand deliver office supplies to the accounting department, before checking a truck load of groceries going to our mine site 800 km away."

"With forklifts, front-end loaders, semi-trailer trucks, containers and countless pieces of equipment and goods coming through the marshalling yard, ensuring the workplace is safe is a constant. "We pay attention to how we load and unload materials, store goods and use our equipment to ensure everyone's safety" says Jeff.
