92% of respondents are supportive of increased production of critical minerals from Saskatchewan that provide food and clean energy security.


Nearly all (93%) of respondents believe the mining industry is important to Saskatchewan

91% of respondents are confident that mining companies will continue to play an important role

in Saskatchewan

1,000 households were randomly selected throughout Saskatchewan to participate in the survey (500 landline and mobile telephone respondents and 500 online respondents).

<u>Majority of respondents</u> think the province's mining industry is supportive of goals to reduce greenhouse gases.

87% of respondents are confident that Saskatchewan's mining industry can continue to be competitive with mining industries in other countries.

87% of respondents think mining companies create local jobs by supporting local companies that supply mines with various products and services.
